

Barbara A. Millar Elected Chair of EMBA Council Board

ORANGE, CALIF., Nov. 2, 2012 – Barbara Millar, assistant dean of the MBA for Executives Program at the University of Virginia Darden School of Business, was elected chair of the Executive MBA Council Board of Trustees.

Millar began her term as chair in October. She joined the board in October 2010 and has served as co-chair of the council's Branding Committee for two years, as a member of the 2010 planning committee for the Executive MBA Council conference, and as treasurer of the organization for one year.

At the University of Virginia, Millar served the full-time program through roles in admissions, financial aid, international student advising, and student affairs. In 2005, she was tapped to launch the MBA for Executives Program. Darden welcomed the first cohort in 2006. Millar supported the launch of the Global MBA for Executives Program (GEMBA) through her membership on the faculty design team. Darden's GEMBA program began in 2011.

Before joining Darden, Millar worked for the University of New Hampshire (UNH) Whittemore School of Business and Economics. She was program manager for its master's programs, and supported the launch of its Executive MBA program. While working full time at UNH, she earned her undergraduate degree in social work and her master's degree in counseling psychology. She received her doctorate in education (higher education leadership) at the University of Virginia Curry School of Education in 1999.
